PUPIL PREMIUM

Pupil Premium is additional funding given to schools in order to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils of all abilities and to close the gap between them and their peers.

The funding allowance for pupils eligible for free school meals is:

-£1,320 for students up to year 6.

-£935 for students in years 7-11.

Students who are classed as being looked after are eligible to receive £1900.

This report meets the requirements of the DFE to publish how much pupil premium funding was received for the 2015-2016 academic year as well as the impact this had on pupils. This report also fulfils the requirement to publish the main barriers to educational achievement that the disadvantaged students in the school face, how we will use the funding in 2016-2017 to address these barriers and how the impact will be measured.
